Trending upwards but not quite pushing through...

The Pound, Euro and the Loonie (Canadian dollar) all gained around 3-4 cents over the past 30 days against the US Dollar, however they never managed to push through those all important trigger levels. Although the fundamentals move the currency markets, pushing through a certain level will tend to drive gains further than normal because it starts a 'trigger' buying system. The Pound looked like it

would push through 1.60 against the Dollar at the start of March, but never quite made it; reaching a high of 1.5933. Traders lost interest resulting in a couple of cents movement downwards. Should it have hit 1.60, I am sure we would have seen Sterling move a couple of cents in the other direction, but this is the intricate dance the forex market plays between actual data and speculative trading. This month, we will need to see some positive data to get back up in the high 1.50's, coupled with some bullish investors to get it over the 1.60 hurdle.

There is nothing like the smell of gingerbread baking, and it is really easy to make. It keeps well, and is good served as a cake, or warmed up with a bit of custard or lemon sauce over it as a dessert. Hope you enjoy my version, a nice comfort food

Gingerbread

2 eggs 3/4 cup black treacle or dark brown molasses 1/2 cup butter 1 cup brown sugar 1 cup boiling water 2 1/2 cups all purpose flour 1/2 tsp baking powder 2 tsp baking powder 2 tsp ground ginger 3/4 tsp ground cardamom 1/2 tsp nutmeg

Beat the eggs and sugar together until thick. Beat in the treacle (helps to slightly warm in the microwave first) Cut the butter into small pieces and let melt in the hot water. Mix the remaining ingredients and add to the egg mixture alternately with the butter/water mixture. Combine thoroughly and pour into a 8"X8" square pan. Bake in a 400 F oven for 30-40 minutes.


Tom Lodge
