## SARASOTA HISTORICAL TIDBIT

In 1885 a Scots colony was established in Sarasota which became the home of soldier, land developer, and business man, Colonel John Hamilton Gillespie from Edinburgh. In two years he built a hotel, and a church and by 1902 became the first mayor. As an avid golfer, having learned the game at St Andrews, among his early achievements was the construction in May 1886 of the first golf course in Florida and only the second in the U.S. It was initially two holes on his property followed in 1905 by his nine-hole course on property that is now the site of the Sarasota County Courthouse. He went on to lay out courses in Tampa, Winter Park and Havana, Cuba.

Col. Gillespie was subsequently elected to five additional one-year mayoral terms. He is credited as being a founder of the local library, and upon his ordainment as a Deacon, being instrumental in founding the Episcopal Church in Sarasota and is acknowledged as the founder of The Church of the Redeemer, Sarasota.
