Introducing Club Members — Norman & Mary Shelley

Back to modern times now..My name is Norman Shelley born in Buxton Derbyshire..more recently before decamping to the sunshine I was living in Exeter working for various church organisations..mainly the Exeter United Reform Church..this may seem unlikely but life takes strange paths..before this I ran a pub restaurant in Cornwall ..which probably does seem likely..before that Engineering..etc..

Mary was born and raised in California and before seeking enlightenment and white wine in Sarasota she was a dental nurse for more teeth than she could count..We first stumbled into one another via the internet in 2002, meeting up for the first time in 2006 and marrying on Siesta Key beach in Febuary '09 ..and so here we are.. *Thats it..as ever..Mary and Norman Shelley*

One of the regular newsletter advertisements is for UK 2 US Wealth run by club member lan Manwaring

Q: Ian. what is UK 2 US Wealth?

A: It's a specialist independent financial advisory arm of my UK practice (regulated by the UK Financial Services Authority). It offers fee based UK advice to US based Brits but a brief initial assessment is always free.

Q: Why did you set it up?

A: Having visited Florida for nearly 20 years, I find that most Brits in the US receive little or no advice on their UK pensions, ISA's, Bonds and general wealth once they have left the UK. There is also confusion about how US tax residency impacts.

Q: Why do you think this is?

A: Three main reasons; firstly, local US advisers are not regulated to advise on UK products and so steer clear of helping Brits. Second, the vast majority of UK advisers don't possess sufficient cross-border tax knowledge to keep advising on UK financial products. I figure the third reason is good old complacency – out of sight, out of mind!

Q: How can you help on UK pensions & investments?

A: Well, an analysis of what a client has is so crucial. After this, I may advise on whether to change the product, or the investment funds within because of US/UK tax, reduce the level of risk or move offshore for tax efficiency. For clients who left the UK with frozen pensions then there are a variety of options, including flexibility, portability and possible access.

Q: OK, so what about help on the US side of things?

A: I'm not allowed to give specific advice on US products but I've have a number of US financial/tax professional contacts, some British, who understand the cross border issues and would be happy to advise SBC members. They include a financial adviser, CPA and estate planner.

Q: Finally lan, how do you meet with your clients?

A: I try to be flexible. Telephony, post and e-mail caters for most needs. For those comfortable with internet I can hold web-meetings, and in addition I normally try to visit Florida once a year when I catch up with my business contacts so can meet with new and existing clients.
