We have made three trips so far in our new RV, including most recently a visit to Koreshan State Park in Estero (Ft Myers). This park is the site of the Koreshan Unity, a commune-type sect founded in the late 1800's by Cyrus

Teed, who brought a group of followers to the site at the turn of the 19/20 century. Many of the buildings have been preserved and volunteers provide interesting tours of them, together with a fascinating demonstration of the early gasoline engine that powered an electric generator.
