COMING EVENTS – EVENTBRITE

Eventbrite – Our New Event Management Tool

Members will have seen recent emails using Eventbrite to announce and manage attendance at our events. Once we all get used to it, we are confident that it will greatly simplify the process of signing up and paying for future events. Here is how it works;

- Using the Eventbrite web site, we create an invitation for the event, and determine a cost if appropriate. There is a modest fee for events that require payment, which we build into the cost. There is no charge for free events (such as our monthly lunches).
- The first time you receive an Eventbrite invitation you will create an account with them. You may well have already done this, and your computer will recognize this.
- If it is a free event, once you have created your account you can register. The system will create tickets, but we will not use them, **so you do not need to print or save them.**
- If the event requires payment, you will see a payment screen which accepts all major credit cards. Again, while the system creates 'tickets' **we will not use them**.
- Once you have registered or paid for the event, you will receive an email confirming that you are subscribed. You are DONE!
- If you are unable to attend, refund information is shown on the event invitation. This is handled on line also, if within the time limits set by the organizer.
- The organizer is now removed from dealing with checks and the mail, and a live list of attendees is available on line.

It is self-evident that members must have a valid email address, and Eventbrite should be added to the safe senders list of your email service (so that invitations do not go into your junk mail).

We have a few members who do not use email. We ask that they partner with other members to ensure that they receive notice, and respond if necessary. If this is a problem, please speak with a member of the board.

We are confident that this new process will prove to be much more efficient for us all. Thank you in advance for your patience while we become familiar with it.

Sarasota British Club Event Policy

Members who would like to attend any SBC function must reserve and pay no later than the stipulated deadline for each event.

The Board asks everyone to please honor the Club's policy and not show up at any event for which they have not booked and paid. Several functions are extremely popular and there is often a limit on the number of people who can be accommodated.
