#### RESIDENTIAL REALTY UPDATE

It is the end of 2018 – gosh did that fly by faster than a reindeer on Christmas Day! Personally I have escaped the Florida heat and sunshine for a few days of more traditional weather in Atlanta but here is my regular update:

November can generally be a bit slow on the housing front as everyone is awaiting the surge of snow birds as this is traditionally our big selling season, however this November compared to last year was up on Sales, Median Prices and Inventory, and likely the poor weather accounts for this anomaly. So talking of inventory, we appear to be stocking up for a big sell in the New Year. The available housing has increased 9.9% compared to last November, that breaks down to Sarasota single family homes increased by 16.3 percent to 3,131 available properties, while Manatee increased by 4.1 percent to 2,229. Sarasota condo inventory increased by 9.5 percent to 1,811, while Manatee condo inventory is up by 5.6 percent to 931 available properties. A rising inventory favors the buyer giving them more choice and the increased competition can lower prices, though most sellers will be willing to wait a couple of months for the potential influx of snowbirds, so still a 'sellers market' at the moment.

**Killing Eve** lived up to the reviews that we read in advance. Sandra Oh was an unlikely heroine, an MI5 analyst obsessed with catching a female assassin. In typical BBC fashion, everybody nice was killed, and the series ended with a cliff-hanger. Only available on DVD at present but well worth it.

Another DVD disc series that we enjoyed was "The Night Of". Its connection to the Old Country is that it is based on a BBC series, Criminal Justice (which is not available on either Netflix or Amazon). A very dark and disturbing tale of a young man accused of murder, but excellent production and graphic content.

If Santa brought you an *Echo* or *Google* device at Christmas, you can listen free to all BBC radio channels and podcasts. Excellent!

We listen to Jeremy Vine on BBC Radio 2 each morning (on our Google Home device). This morning he interviewed Gyles Brandreth, who has written a new book about the English Language called "*Have you eaten Grandma?*"
