RESIDENTIAL REALTY UPDATE

We all like good news so the optimistic version of the real estate news would say Sarasota and Manatee have had more home sales so far in 2018 than all the sales for the same period last year, which is true, but at just a 1% increase, it is not 'hold the presses' news worthy! But it is a steady increase, and I say, this is a good thing, let's not create another boom and bust, real estate bubble. Steady manageable increases are good for everyone. Following this marginal trend, median house prices in Bradenton are slightly up with a 2% increase and 8% in Sarasota. The actual number of sales are also, slightly up.

Following the trend of last month condos are selling very well, but this month we flipped the counties Mantatee Condos sold better with 278 sales, a 16.8% increase over last year, while Sarasota which was the 'star sales' last month, lags behind with 452 sales, a 6.4% increase. Single Family homes overall are still sluggish. In Manatee they are up 2.6% (641 sales) while Sarasota had another decrease by a fractional 0.2% (820 sales). I have two noticeable points for the month of May, firstly, my crystal ball forecast from last month, we do have a further shortage of inventory, making it another month of tight supply, which is likely to drive prices up, so if you have a property to sell you have less competition.

In my opinion it's a sellers market with low inventory... that's good selling time. Finally, my reflection on May: I recall that historically sales were concentrated 'in-season' Jan – Easter, but we are now in May and still seeing steadily increasing sales, that's good news as you don't always want to sell in just the first quarter, a more even spread of sales year around, is better for sellers, and opportunities for buyers. This is more of the steady that I like.
