## RESIDENTIAL REALTY UPDATE

Hi my fellow Brits,

We are well into Snow Bird season, so avoid the traffic and despite the friendly annual invasion, remember to be thankful, these annual migrants help pay for us all to enjoy the more tranquil rest of the year here in paradise!

I prefer to be the bringer of good news, and this month is usually the start of record sales in all property departments, but this month, as they say in Mary Poppins "Winds in the east, mist coming in, / Like somethin' is brewin' and bout to begin. / Can't put me finger on what lies in store, / But I fear what's to happen all happened before." Which is a rather dramatic way of saying I forecast a change in the property market. I think this is the end of our 'sellers market' and we will be changing instead into a 'buyers market'. The indicators for this are sales are down 17.2% compared to Jan 2018, and inventory is up by 12.3%. To officially identify when a market is oversupplied – we take the average number of houses being sold and compare this with the number of houses available (the inventory) if this is over 5.5 months supply then we are thinking we have to many houses to sell! In Sarasota for houses we have a 5.4 month supply and for Condos we have 6.1 months supply, In Manatee, houses are at 4.4 months and 4.7 months for Condos. The good news is that actual median sales prices still went up slightly this month, but I think this is the top of that sales curve.
